In the past 40 years, Michael McLean has sold more than 1.5 million copies of his more than 40 albums, 7 books and various videos. He is a songwriter, composer, author, performer, playwright, film producer and director. With a background in film, Michael began early in his career making commercials for radio and television, and later used his film experience to produce and direct several films, including Together Forever, The Prodigal Son, and Mr. Krueger's Christmas, starring film legend Jimmy Stewart.

He released his debut album, You're Not Alone, in 1983 and from there began a best-selling musical legacy. Since 1991, Michael has performed The Forgotten Carols for more than 1 million people across the country, and "the Carols" has become a beloved tradition for thousands of families who mark the beginning of their holiday season with this magical musical. Last year the holiday release in movie theaters of the stage to screen adaptation of The Forgotten Carols was a top 10 box office hit nationwide. 
